Our Campaign

Through prayer, conversation, and research, we have decided to address St. James' needs through a \$450,000 campaign in conjunction with the Episcopal Church in Connecticut: *Joining Jesus*.

This extraordinary effort will be unlike any our parish has previously undertaken, and success will depend on the prayerful participation of our loyal families and friends. Our campaign will support the following priorities:



\$100,000

Address capital projects to preserve and protect our sacred space for worship and community

Beginning with the red doors, St. James' long celebrated and landmark buildings and grounds have always been a part of what make our parish such a warm, inviting, and welcoming community. In addition to **upgrading heating and energy systems** of our beautiful church, St. James' will establish a **capital reserves fund** to cover costs of capital projects that will inevitably arise, receive gifts and bequests with the intent of being maintained on a longer-term basis.

Our grounds are an extension of the church sanctuary and we aim to consider opportunities to develop features that support church life and raise our visibility and presence within our community. With the funds raised through this campaign we hope to **repurpose our spaces** to make them more functional, **increase accessibility** in key spaces so all feel welcome and able to participate, **develop an outdoor chapel**, and **address parking needs**.

Support Camp Washington as a resource for faith formation in our state

Camp Washington is ECCT's camp and retreat center, and it has been a site for spiritual respite for over 100 years. From summer camp to adult retreats to diocesan events, **Camp Washington** is a year-round center for discipleship rooted in the beauty of God's creation and love. Funding from St. James' will support **facilities enhancements and expanded programming** to serve as ECCT's primary resource for Christian formation in Connecticut.



How You Can Help

The Joining Jesus campaign seeks participation of all God's people at St. James' to ensure our continued vitality in participating in God's mission and sharing God's love with our neighbors.

Each family or individual's financial situation is different — and ability to give can change from time to time. Methods of Giving

- **Pledges** payable over three to five years, with payments made by check, credit card, electronic fund transfer, stock transfers, or recommendations to Donor Advised Funds.
- **Planned gifts** by designating St. James' as a beneficiary in your will.
- **Gifts of stock**, which will be sold as soon as they are received.
- **IRA Transfer** to allow donating directly from your retirement assets.
